

2023 OCAC Global Mandarin Speaking Competition

Notification of Personal Data Collection, Processing and Use

- I. The notification is made in accordance with Article 8 of the Personal Data Protection Act (hereinafter referred to as the "PDPA") of the Republic of China (Taiwan).
- II. Organization: The Overseas Community Affairs Council (hereinafter referred to as "the OCAC"), which delegated the personal information handling to its overseas secretaries, overseas missions, and the outsourced supplier.
- III. Purpose of Collection: The purpose of collecting, processing, and using the personal data of participants is for registration, administration, and follow-up communication related to "2023 OCAC Global Mandarin Speaking Competition" (hereinafter referred to as "the competition"), and it is subject to the PDPA and related regulations.
- IV. Categories of Personal Data: The personal data collected and used in this event include the participant's country of residence, the name of the compatriot school or the Taiwan Center for Mandarin Learning attended, name, date of birth, and email address.
- V. Personal Data Processing and Utilization:
- V.i. Personal Data Usage Period: The period of personal data usage starts from the registration for the competition until the completion of the purpose of data collection.
 - V.ii. Areas of Using the Personal Data: Taiwan (within the territory of the Republic of China), the participant's place of residence, and the areas authorized by the participant for processing and using the personal data.
 - V.iii. Recipients of Personal Data: The OCAC, its overseas secretaries or overseas missions, and the outsourced supplier authorized by the OCAC.
 - V.iv. The Methods of Using Personal Data: The collected data will be used for registration, competition result recording, contact between parties, statistical analysis, and subsequent follow-up work.
- VI. In accordance with the PDPA, participants may exercise the following rights in writing with the OCAC regarding their personal data: (1) request to inquire or access; (2) request to obtain a copy; (3) request to supplement or correct; (4) request to stop collecting, processing or using; (5) request to delete.
- VII. If the participant fails to provide correct and complete personal information required by the OCAC to conduct the competition, the participant should provide legitimate and sufficient reasons for the omission. Otherwise, the participant will not be able to complete the registration process and will forfeit the right to participate in the competition.
